

Code of Honor and Academic Integrity

The purpose of a code of honor and academic integrity policy is to assure that students are aware of their responsibility of honorable professional behavior and conduct. It is expected that all students accepting admission to Wolford College promote the highest standards of ethical conduct and academic integrity.

Students are expected to demonstrate honesty and integrity in both the classroom and the clinical setting. Violation of the Code of Honor and Academic Integrity will subject a student to disciplinary action, up to and including administrative dismissal. Violation includes but is not limited to any of the following:

- Intentional and unauthorized falsification, fabrication or alteration of any records, information or documents.
- Intentionally or knowingly helping or attempting to help another individual in an act of academic dishonesty.
- Cheating on any course assignment or examination, which may include but is not limited to referring to unauthorized materials, having another person take an exam for the student, or changing answers after test papers or answer sheets have been given to the instructor.
- Plagiarizing, which includes the submission of other's ideas or papers (whether purchased, borrowed or otherwise obtained) as one's own.
- Collaborating with others in work to be presented, if contrary to stated rules of the course.
- Having another person perform one's (anesthesia) care without the instructor's knowledge and permission.
- Communicating false information about care given to patients.
- Intentionally or knowingly destroying, stealing or making inaccessible any library or other academic material.
- Acting in an action that would be considered discriminatory.
- Engaging in any form of sexual harassment.
- Fraternalizing (sexual involvement) with the faculty or the clinical instructors (MD's or CRNA's).
- Knowingly and intentionally assisting another student in any of the above actions
- Failure to disclose accurate financial information for Federal Financial Aid.
